### Introduction

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into effect on May 25<sup>th</sup> 2018, detailing how personal data can be used and stored.

This policy outlines how Early Years Outdoor Learning gathers and uses your personal information.

## This policy details the following:

- The type of data collected
- How the data is used
- How data is stored

### What data is collected?

The following may be collected:

- Name
- Address
- Email / postal address
- Photos
- Financial information

### Data is used for the following purposes:

- Marketing to offer promotions, training and other services to the early years sector
  - Anonomised photos may be used on the website
  - Invoicing and payment for services

#### How is the data stored and who has access?

 All reasonable technical and organisational precautions to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of your personal data is undertaken.

## How long is the data kept?

- Email addresses for those who have subscribed to the mailing list will be kept on file until such time individuals unsubscribe
- Bank details for commissioned services will be kept only as long as reasonably needed for tax purposes

#### Who is the data shared with?

- Data is for use of Early Years Outdoor Learning only and is NOT shared with third parties for marketing purposes
- Early Years Outdoor Learning uses Mail Chimp (an email marketing tool) to distribute emails for marketing purposes. You can view their privacy policy here
